We are a wholly-owned subsidiary of Daimler AG, the inventor of the automobile, one of the biggest producers of premium cars and the world's largest manufacturer of commercial vehicles. Mercedes AMG HPP are a team of over 500 people responsible for the complete design, manufacture and testing of every single Formula One engine to wear the Mercedes-Benz badge as well as for our customer teams Aston Martin, McLaren and Williams. We also participate in Formula E and are engaged with various advanced technology projects for our parent company Daimler.

Mercedes-Benz has a rich motorsport history: competing in the first motor race in 1894, in Formula One in 1954 and 1955, returning to supply engines from 1994 onwards and more recently becoming a dominant force with the works team, the modern Silver Arrows. Maintaining such a racing heritage is both a privilege and a responsibility and we take great pride in continuing the tradition.

We are very proud of our recent project, working with engineers at University College London on the UCL-Ventura breathing aid, a Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP) device, helping Covid-19 patients with lung infections to breathe more easily, when an oxygen mask alone is insufficient. Following a commission from the UK government, the team manufactured 10,000 devices, with the devices and supporting kit now being used in over 120 NHS hospitals across the United Kingdom.

Here at Brixworth, as the use of technology in our workplace evolves, we understand the importance of electrical engineers, specifically in the Motor Control area, in order to continue to develop and progress. We are explicitly aware of the role of students as part of a future talent pipeline and intend to provide advice, support and guidance to our scholars to ensure a high quality experience. We hope to provide a stimulating and challenging environment that inspires young engineers to pursue a career in Motor Control.
